1. Please provide a list of Consultants who are providing/have provided their services since January, 2013 & till date in Ministry of Home Affairs.
2. Please provide a list of Consultants appointed in Ministry of Home Affairs since January, 2013 & till date, who have not retired from service from Ministry of Home Affairs.
3. What is the process of appointment of Consultants in Ministry of Home Affairs & what steps are taken to ensure fairness & transparency in such appointments.
4. In how many number of cases of appointment of Consultants in Ministry of Home Affairs since January, 2013 open advertisements have been given in newspapers & if no such advertisements were given then specify the reasons for the same.
5. In how many number of cases Consultants have been paid for their days of absence from duty in Ministry of Home Affairs since January, 2013.
6. In how many number of cases the attendance of Consultants have been verified from the records of Biometric System before granting them salary/payment even after submission of certificates given by their Controlling Officers.
7. What action has been taken/can be taken against Consultants who submit false certificates signed/recommended by their Controlling Officers for claiming salary/payment even for the days of being absent from duty & also what action can be taken against their Controlling officers for providing false certificates.
8. What is the apex age limit fixed for appointment of Consultants in Ministry of Home Affairs & for how many times/tenure any Consultant can be given extension in this Ministry.
9. Please give me time to observe the file notings & for taking down notes related to the appointment of Consultants in Ministry of Home Affairs since January, 2013.
