Background Information:

- A) Undersigned had filed the RTI Application dated 07.12.2011 with 'Ministry of Home Affairs' to know as to what is the policy/norms prescribed for 'Delhi Police' and 'Union Territory Police', to retain CCTV Cameras Video recording, installed at public places for the maximum or minimum number of days and subsequently, application was transfer with Delhi Police and afterwards, information was provided vide letter/reply dated 11.01.2012.
- B) In reply to application, it has been contemplated that, "there is no policy/norms prescribed by the Ministry of Home Affairs, available in the Police Headquarters and while going through the reply dated 11.01.2011 (Copy enclosed), it cannot be presumed that as to whether there is any policy or not because, answering officer had alleged that, 'no policy/norms available in this headquarters'.
- C) Therefore, approach the 'public authority' of the 'Ministry of Home Affairs', to provide information under Section 2(f) of the RTI, Act-2005 in form of 'opinion', advises in explicit manner, as under:
 - a) Whether any policy/norms was formulated by the 'Ministry of Home Affairs' to retain CCTV Cameras Video recording, installed at public places for the maximum or minimum number of days, if 'yes' provide copy of the same.
 - b) If 'no', reasons for not-formulating any policy to retain CCTV Cameras footage for maximum or minimum number of days.

Subject: Appeal filed by Shri Aseem Takyar under Section 19(1) of RTI-Act, 2005.



2. Whereas, Shri Aseem Takyar had submitted an RTI application dated 7.12.2011 to this Ministry raising question regarding policy/norms prescribed by the Ministry of Home Affairs for Delhi Police and Union Territory Police to retain Video Recording of CCTV Cameras installed at public places for the maximum or minimum number of days. The application was forwarded to the Delhi Police for necessary action.

3. Whereas, Shri Assem Takyar under section 2(f) of the RTI, Act-2005 had againstsought reply vide his RTI application dated 27.01.2012 on the above subject in the form of 'opinion', 'advices', 'contract' etc. Whereas the subject of the complaint pertained to PM Division and IS-I Division, MHA and as such the same was transferred under section 6(3) of RTI Act, to the concerned authority of PM Division and IS-I Division vide our communication No.F.No.14011/311/2011-UIP dated 16.02.2012(copy enclosed) for necessary action.
