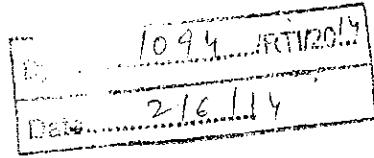

Sir,
I Padamnabh upadhyay roll no. 008844 has been finally selected in CAPF 2012 exam and has been allotted border security force which was my fourth preference. Sir I would like to request you to kindly allot any other force according to my first three preferences, if any candidate has not been willing to join CISF SSB or ITBP and vacancy is created in the respective forces

Sir I want to know that if any of the selected candidates do not join their allotted force so the vacancy in their respective forces is been filled by the same batch candidates or not and we are allowed to take the vacancy which was our preferred forces. Sir please tell me what happen to these vacancies.

Under right to information act I would like to get these information.

1. How many candidates in CAPF AC exam 2011 have joined their respective forces and how many seats were vacant. Whether these seats were carried forwarded or they have been offered to other lower rank candidates.
2. If these seats are carried forwarded then on basis of which government order and ruling it is done.
3. How many candidates in CAPF AC 2012 exam have joined CISF, SSB and ITBP and how many seats of general candidates is vacant.
4. What is the purpose of reserved list if it is declared only after a month of the final result.
5. Even in civil services if any candidate do not join the lower rank, candidate gets the offer of appointment to its higher preferred service, so why it is not here in the CAPF AC as both the exams are conducted by the same UPSC and like IPS these all come under home ministry.
