

Please provide information with respect to questions based on <u>human right</u> and <u>corruption</u> in our central armed police forces (CAPF).

- 1. Is there any guideline famed by government of India or security forces to provide weekly off to the paramilitary personnel's. Please provide detailed credentials.
- 2. What is ministries opinion about instructions against personal practice of using cooks, washer man, cobblers, sweepers by the officers and their relatives? The cooks and other staff work at home, but officially they are shown working in police kitchens. What is percentage of persons not included in general duty staff?
- 3. What are the steps that government has taken to eradicate suicide in paramilitary forces? Sources say tough working conditions and falling prey to alcoholism are few reasons. What are the methods adopted to discourage over usage of alcohol and improve working conditions?
- 4. How many forces could successfully adopt a "buddy" system under which a jawan can share his/her problem with a fellow jawan; is there any case study done by forces or ministry to find effectiveness after application of this program? Provide findings of study pre and post program application.
- 5. How many psychologists and counsellors are hired to help stressed-out jawans?
- 6. What are the steps that ministry has taken to make paramilitary forces more attractive for youngsters. A study done last year found out that some 51,000 personnel's had quit in the past five years.
- 7. Can a citizen seek information from a unit of CISF headed by commandant regarding weekly offs given to force members, number of jawans assist him in his official work and personal work at home? Kindly provide the list of matters /subjects which can be submitted to avail information from paramilitary forces or commandant of a unit force under RTI.
- 8. Are public redressals of grievances mechanism applicable to paramilitary forces also? Kindly provide the procedure to approach.
- 9. If a junior is harassed/mistreated by his/her senior, who can be approached by a junior so that his/her problem is addressed and processed successfully?
- 10. What is the definition of "respecting your senior" with respect to Paramilitary forces?
- 11. There are various circulars or policies that ministry has forwarded to improve functioning of Paramilitary forces and facilities for member jawans. Is there any functioning body within or outside the organization which keeps a watch on implementation of it?
- 12. What are the steps that government have taken to find ground realities of combat capabilities in counter-insurgency operations carried out by CRPF in naxal affected areas.

- 14. How many persons are dismissed from the service found guilty of corruption. Which force is found to be most corrupt based on the previous year i.e. 2013 statistics among all the paramilitary forces?
- 15. What steps government has taken to break nexus of jawans and officers pertaining to corruption?
- 16. It is found that during transfer, group of jawans use a single vehicle for transportation and show it separate while claiming LTC. Similar kind of fraud practice is taking place in medical claim under CGHS. How many persons are found guilty of fraudulent practices that include fake bill of LTC and medical claim?
