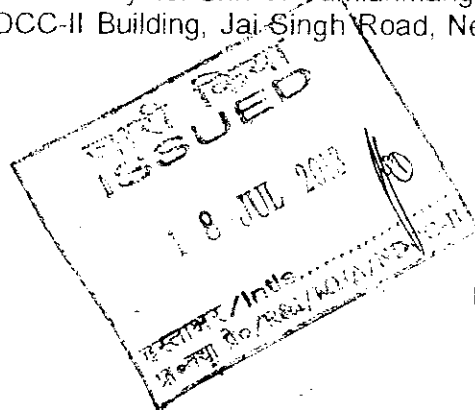
Sir,
