




Subject: Information sought under the RTI Act, 2005

Sir,

Please refer to your application dated 25.03.2013 (received by the undersigned on 08.07.2013 on transfer from Shri S. Samanta, Under Secretary(RTI), Ministry of Home Affairs, vide their O.M. No.A-43020/01/2013/-RTI dated 04.07.2013) seeking information under the RTI Act, 2005.

2. With regard to information sought by you in point nos. 1 and 2 of your RTI application, it may be stated that an application for issue of a PIO card shall be made to an Indian Mission in the country where the applicant is ordinarily resident. Applicants already in India on Long Term Visa(more than one year) shall make the application for issue of a PIO card to the following authorities :-

(i) Those residing in :-

- (a) Delhi-Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, Level-II, East Block VIII, R.K. Puram Sector-I, New Delhi
- (b) Mumbai- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, Annexe-II, Commissioner of Police, Crawford Market, Mumbai-400001
- (c) Kolkata- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, 237, Acharya Jagdish Chandra Bose Road, Kolkata-700020
- (d) Amritsar- Additional Deputy Director, Bureau of Immigration, B/123, Ranjeet Avenue, Amritsar.
- (e) Chennai- Chief Immigration Officer, Bureau of Immigration, Shastri Bhavan Annexe, No.26, Haddows Road, Chennai-600006.
- (f) Bangalore- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, Cauvery Bhavan, 9th floor, Bangalore
- (g) Hyderabad- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, SIB Office, Kothi, Hyderabad
- (h) Ernakulam- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, Immigration Wing, CIAL, P.O. Nedumbassery, Ernakulam, Kerala.
- (i) Trivandrum- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, 572, Mont Fort House, Vazhuthacaud, P.O. Thucound, Trivandrum-695014.
- (j) Panji- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, Goa, Panji.
- (k) Calicut- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, Calicut, Kerala
- (i) Lucknow- Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, Lucknow, (CCS Airport), U.P.

(ii) Those residing in areas other than above shall make application to Joint Secretary (Foreigners), Ministry of Home Affairs, Foreigners Division, NDCC-II Building, Jai Singh Road, OFF Parliament Street, New Delhi-110001. Details are also available on this Ministry's website www.mha.nic.in- Citizens Service- Foreigners Division.

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3. The application form for grant of PIO card is available on the Ministry's website www.mha.nic.in under Citizen Services- Foreigners Division. The documents to be attached to the application are :-

- (i) Copy of Indian Passport/Travel document of the applicant or either of his/her parents or grand parents or great grand parents or Proof of previous Indian nationality of the applicant or either of his/her parents or grand parents or great grand parents or Any other document satisfactorily proving nationality of the applicant as an Indian.
- (ii) 04 Passport size photographs of the applicant,
- (iii) Demand Draft of Rs 15,000 (for adults) Rs 7,500 (for minors) drawn in favour of concerned FRRO (in case of application submitted to Ministry of Home Affairs, Demand Draft should be in favour of FRRO, Delhi)
- (iv) Copy of valid visa for at least 06 months (if already in India),
- (v) Copy of foreign passport.
- (vi) Thumb impression in case of minor.

No time limit has been laid down for grant of PIO card. Normally, subject to production of all requisite documents to the satisfaction of the issuing authority and nothing adverse against the individual, a PIO card is issued within 3-4 months.

4. With regard to information sought by you in point no 3 of the RTI application, it may be stated that if any foreigner obtains a PIO card by virtue of being a spouse of an Indian national or of a PIO, and latter on, he/she divorces the Indian/PIO spouse, the Indian/PIO spouse must inform the authorities for cancellation of PIO card. Even otherwise, if it comes to the notice of PIO issuing authorities that any such PIO card holder has divorced his/her Indian/PIO spouse, the authority concerned may cancel his/her PIO card. In cases of spouses of Indian Citizens where the Indian citizen has expired, it may be ensured that the applicant for a PIO Card was not a divorcee and that he/she has not remarried and that there is no complaint from either side before issuing a PIO card.

5. If you are not satisfied with the information furnished, you may file an appeal to Shri V. Vumlynmang, Joint Secretary (Foreigners) & Appellate Authority, Ministry of Home Affairs, Foreigners Division, NDCC-II Building, Jai Singh Road, New Delhi within the prescribed time limit.
