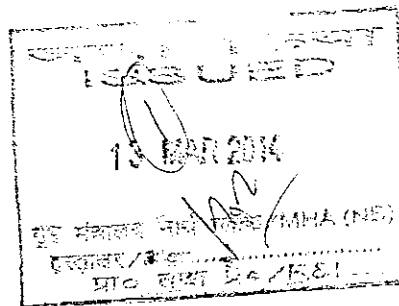

P.C. against the author, printer, publisher, possessor etc. You may, therefore, kindly take up the matter with the State Governments/UTs concerned in this matter.

3. In case you are not satisfied with the above reply, as per Section 19(1) of Right to Information Act, 2005 you may file an appeal within 30 days from the issue of this letter to the first Appellate Authority whose particulars are given below:
