Please refer to your RTI application dated 26.05.2014, which received in this section on 01.07.2014 as transferred by Mrs. Sulekha, Deputy Secretary (K-II) and CPIO, Ministry of Home Affairs vide letter no. 13030/9/2014-K.II dated 30th June 2014. The information in respect of Para 2 of your application, pertaining to this section is as under:-

- i) PM's Package (2008) for Kashmiri Migrants: It has been the Government's stated Policy to provide various rehabilitation facilities to the Kashmiri migrants and to create an environment conducive enough to make them return to the Valley. A package for Rs. 1618.40 Crore was announced by Hon'ble Prime Minister in 2008 to facilitate the return of the Kashmiri Migrants to the Valley, which provides for many comprehensive facilities for the migrants e.g. financial assistance for purchase/ construction of houses, repair/ renovation of damaged houses and dilapidated/ unused houses, construction of transit accommodation, Continuations of Cash relief to migrants, students scholarship, Employment, Assistance to the Agriculturists and the Horticulturist and Waiver of interest on unpaid loan etc.
- ii) Cash relief: Initially J&K Govt. after registering migrant family, provided case relief of Rs.250/- per family and free ration, which has been enhanced from time to time. At present, the cash relief has been enhanced to Rs.1650/- per head per month (maximum Rs.6600/- per family per month) plus dry ration (9 Kg. Rice, 2Kg. Atta per soul per month and 1 Kg. Sugar per family per month) to eligible 17,248 families living in Jammu.
- iii) Ex-gratia relief: As per the policy with the Central Government for providing ex-gratia relief to the NOKs (Next Of Kins) of the victims of the militancy. Central Govt. is providing a cash relief of Rs.3 lakhs each to the NoKs of J&K police personnel killed in terrorism related incident.

(2)	<p>Insofar as J&K Division (K.II Desk) is concerned, we provide funds to the State Govt. of J&K under Security Related Expenditure (SRE) Scheme. The details of SRE is given below:</p> <p>Security Related Expenditure (SRE) Scheme</p> <p>In view of the serious militancy/insurgency in J&K, the Govt. of J&K have to incur more expenditure for maintaining peace and tranquility. It has led to an additional burden on its budget. In order to mitigate this problem and with a view to augment the resources of the J&K Government to fight the terrorism and contain militancy besides maintaining law and order in the State, a separate SRE scheme for J&K was introduced. It provides for reimbursement of expenditure on Police (SRE - Police) which mainly support the logistical requirements of police force of J&K and Relief & Rehabilitation (SRE-R&R), which support the expenditure on relief and rehabilitation of the Kashmiri migrants who have been uprooted from the valley during militancy period. 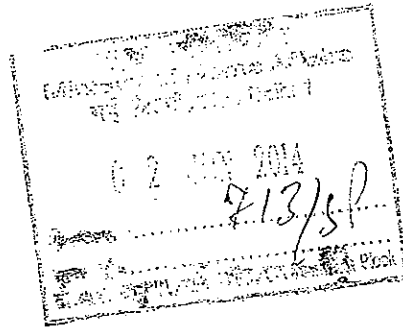
