

(f) Shall the MIA Court be exclusive for N.I.A. cases or will take additional responsibilities existing in their sessions court.


(g) What provisions have been made to preside over the court when the permanent judge is sick, on leave, absent, on deputation, etc. and from where the power to officiate will flow?

2. As far as IS-II Section of IS-I Division is concerned, the information sought by the applicant does not relate to this Division.

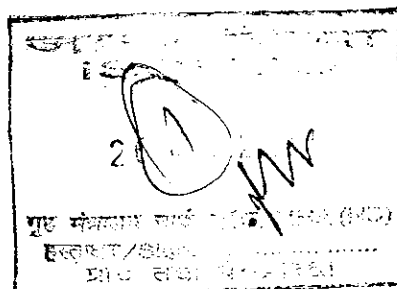
