Point (1)	No.	No such incident has come to notice
Point (2)	No.	As per para 8(iii) of the Guidelines for Transfer/posting of IAS/IPS officers of Joint AGMU cadre, 2010, the officers of State Civil Service/State Police Service after induction/promotion to IAS/IPS will also be liable for transfer like any other IAS/IPS officer.
Point (3)	No.	The period, for which the information required, is not mentioned. However, as per point No.6, the requisite information of the DANICS/DANIPS officers, inducted in IAS/IPS of AGMUT cadre after 2010, are enclosed.
Point (4)	No.	The last meeting of the Joint Cadre Authority was convened on 16.07.2014. A list of all the IAS & IPS officers in position in the cadre was placed before JCA in its meeting. Copies of the file noting are enclosed.
Point (5)	No.	The Joint Cadre Authority of AGMUT cadre for IAS & IPS comprises the following officers:- 1. Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs 2. Chief Secretary, Arunachal Pradesh 3. Chief Secretary, Goa 4. Chief Secretary, Mizoram 5. Chief Secretary, Delhi 6. Joint Secretary (Union Territories Division) Ministry of Home Affairs (Convenor)

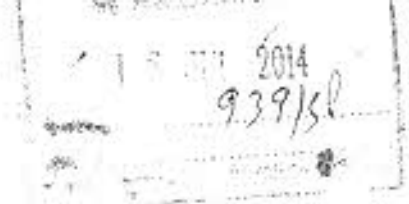




SUB: RTI APPLICATION

The following information be supplied under the RTI Act, 2005 :

1. Is it true that UT division of MHA is indulging in favouritism in respect of well connected promotee IAS and IPS officers of AGMUT Cadre by not posting them to remote and difficult stations like Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Lakshadweep and Andaman and Nicobar Islands ?
2. Is it true that a promotee IAS and IPS officers of AGMUT Cadre is required to serve in these areas on their promotion to IAS/IPS or next promotion therein as per their Transfer Policies ?
3. What are the names of promotee IAS/IPS officers of AGMUT Cadre who have not served in the aforesaid remote and difficult area as on their promotion to IAS/IPS and/or next promotion therein. What is the total length of their service in delhi and other soft / B station like Chandigarh, Goa, Pondicherry, Daman and Diu etc.
4. When the latest meeting of the Joint Cadre Authority took place and whether the names of these officers was put up by the joint secretary (UT division) and home secretary for their aforesaid remote and difficult areas postings. An authenticated copy of the file notings be supplied.
5. Name and designation of the officers who comprised the aforesaid joint cadre authority.
6. What are the name of promotee IAS/IPS officers who have retired without serving in the aforesaid mentioned remote and difficult areas ? This information is required from year 2010 onwards till date.
7. The aforesaid information is requested only in respect of DANICS & DANIPS officers promoted to IAS & IPS, respectively.
