Please refer to your online RTI application Registration No.MHOMER/2013/60731 dated 23.08.2013 received in this unit on transfer on 28.04.2014.

2. With regard to your queries, it is stated that the subject matter is partly related to this Unit. The subject matter regarding exemption from pre-embarkation security check at the airports is under the jurisdiction of Ministry of Civil Aviation. However, in case of Shri Robert Vadra, Ministry of Home Affairs, in consultation with the Central Security Agencies, has recommended exemption from pre-embarkation security checks at the airport only when he is accompanying a SPG protectee. Further details in this regard are exempted under Section 24(1) of the RTI Act-2005. A copy of your application is also being transferred to CPIO, Ministry of Civil Aviation under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act-2005 for providing information on the remaining points of your application directly to you.

- 3) It has been learned from the media reports that Shri Robert Vadra has been granted such an exemption as a special case because he is married to a SPG Protectee. Hence the applicant wishes to know whether such facility may be extended to the applicant or to any other citizen of India if he has been married to a SPG Protectee?
- 4) Kindly provide copies of all rules and regulations based on which the Government grants exemption from pre-embarkation security checks compromising with the safety and security of other passengers.
