Please refer to your online RTI application Registration No.MHOME/R/2013/61534 dated 25.10.2013 received in this unit on transfer on 29.10.2013. The desired information is as under:

- (1) The responsibility for providing security to an individual is primarily that of the State Government in whose jurisdiction such an individual ordinarily resides or happens to be. Security to an individual is provided on the basis of comprehensive threat assessment carried out by the Central Security Agencies. On the basis of gravity of threat, categorized security cover in different categories i.e. X, Y, Z and Z+ is provided to an individual.
- (2) State Police Forces are responsible for providing security to individuals in their respective jurisdiction. In certain cases CAPFs are also deployed for providing security to individuals.
- (3) Regarding total number of protectees, it is stated that it is not possible to arrive at the exact number of categorized protectees as it varies from time to time based on the reviews carried out taking into account the threat assessment made by the Central Security Agencies. However, there are 218 threat based protectees in the Central list as on date. Details of number of statutory protectee are available with Delhi Police. Accordingly, a copy of your RTI Application is being forwarded to Delhi Police for providing details with regard to number of statutory protectees directly to you.
- (4) Regarding expenditure incurred on providing security, it is stated that provision of security to an individual is primarily the responsibility of the state government concerned, in whose jurisdiction such individual is ordinarily resident or happens to be. Due to the involvement of multiple agencies, including state government agencies, it is difficult to calculate the actual expenditure incurred on providing security cover and such details are not maintained in this office.
