Sir,

Please refer to your RTI application dated 07.11.2013 received in this unit on transfer on 29.11.2013.

2. In this regard, it is stated that the responsibility for providing security to any individual rests primarily with the State Government/UT Administration concerned, in whose jurisdiction such individual is ordinarily resident. Such security to an individual is provided on the basis of threat assessment carried out by Security Agencies. Further details in this regard are exempted under Sections 8(1)(g), 8(1)(j) and 24(1) of the RTI Act-2005. Regarding expenditure occurred in providing security, it is stated that provision of security to an individual is primarily the responsibility of the state government concerned, in whose jurisdiction such individual is ordinarily resident or happens to be. Due to the involvement of multiple agencies, including state government agencies, it is difficult to calculate the actual expenditure incurred on providing security cover and such details are not maintained in this office.
