Please refer to your application dated 08.11.2013 under the RT1 Act, 2005 which was received in this unit on transfer on 29.11.2013.


2. The requisite information is as under:

(i) Security to an individual is provided on the basis of threat perception as assessed by

the Security Agencies.

(ii) Security to Cabinet Ministers is provided primarily on the basis of threat perception attached to the position held by them. Security to Prime Minister is provided on the basis of SPG Act which is available in the public domain (www.spg.nic.in). There are four types of categorized security cover i.e. X, Y, Z and Z+.

3. Security to Chief Minister and Governors is primarily provided by the concerned State Govts./UT Administration as under the Constitution of India "Law and Order" is a State subject. Hence it is the responsibility of the concerned State/Union Territory Government to provide adequate security to the individuals within their area of jurisdiction. Details in this regard can be obtained by approaching the CPIO of the concerned State Govt. separately under the RTI Act-2005.
