





2. On the complaint of Shri Ajit Singh Dhillon, the comments of GEC were sought. The GEC forwarded their comments vide their letter No. 1345/41-E/2012/GEC dated 21-09-2012.
3. Subsequently the GEC was also requested to clarify whether the reimbursement of Petrol made to the Chief Commissioner GEC was in respect of the official journeys performed within the states (Headquarters). In reply the GEC have reiterated their earlier explanation in the matter. In this connection copies of replies received from GEC vide their letter Nos. 487/41-E/2013/GEC dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2013, No.560/41-E/2013/GEC dated 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2013, No.751/41-E/2013/GEC dated 25-11-2013 and No.108/41-E/2014/GEC dated 16-02-2014 are enclosed.
4. It is to further informed that the pay and allowances to Chief Commissioner, Gurdwara Election are paid by Cashier Section under JS(Administration), Ministry of Home Affairs.
5. Copies of the comments/replies received from the Gurdwara Election Commission are forwarded herewith for information and further necessary action.

Sri Ajit Singh Dhillon, Granddigger, has submitted a complaint dated 20-06-2012 against Shri H.S. Brar, Chief Commissioner of CCGE, alleging fraudulent reimbursement of petrol expenses. He had also submitted a copy of his complaint dated 20-03-2012 to CAG, which was forwarded to Vigilance Section by vigilance Section vide note No. 12070/14/2012-VG dated 06.12.12.

2. In his complaint Sri Ajit Singh Dhillon has stated that in a letter dated 09-06-1997, Chief Commissioner, Gurdwara has been allowed to a staff car and 200 litre of petrol per month for the entire duration of petrol whichever is less, The said entitlement of petrol is for official use only of CCGE within the headquarters i.e. Granddigger. Sri Ajit Singh Dhillon has further stated that the distance between his residence of Gurdwara and his office is only 1 Km. and it can be assumed that the staff car covers average distance of 200 Km. only for a week approximately and thus 17 litres of Petrol and it is clear that Sri H.S. Brar has used a staff car for private purpose and has fraudulantly claimed for reimbursement of 180 litres of Petrol.

3. On the complaint of Sri Ajit Singh Dhillon, we sought the attention of GEC. The GEC forwarded their comments vide their letter No. 136249-ET/2012/GEC dated 21-09-2012.

4. Subsequently the GEC was also requested to check the details of reimbursement of Petrol made to the Chief Commissioner, CCGE with respect of the official journeys performed within the headquarters. The GEC have reiterated their earlier explanation in no particular detail but the GEC have not specifically replied to this query. Many remarks have been made but the GEC have not specifically replied to this query.

5. The complaint was forwarded by Vigilance Section to GEC and the same is pending for a long time. Therefore we may not wait for any further clarification from GEC and may forward the same to the Chief Commissioner, Vigilance Section for their consideration after necessary enquiries are made. Please.
