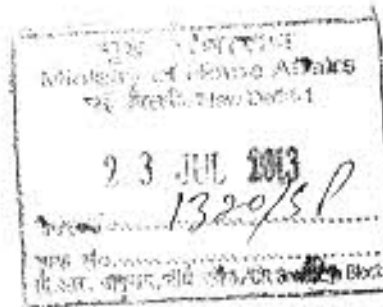

After the conclusion of the Departmental inquiry proceedings which were conducted by the CENTRAL VIGILANCE COMMISSION for the first time at the behest of the then "Chief Secretary Delhi Administration vide his order No: 7(1)/82-vig/3104 dated 9-06-1986 had appointed "Shri S.P.K. Naidu I.A.S. Central vigilance Commissioner in the C.V.C. Organisation" to inquire into the charges framed against the undersigned applicant vide charge sheet issued to the undersigned on 15-04-1986 by the then disciplinary authority, the Chief Secretary Govt. of Delhi.

5) Initially the ^{Police} vigilance inquiry was conducted in this connection by ^{an} A.C.P. of Delhi Police (Vigilance Branch) with which the Directorate of Vigilance of Govt. of Delhi perhaps was not satisfied and the matter was referred by the competent authority of the administration to the Central Bureau of Investigation New Delhi for fresh investigation. The C.B.I. on the receipt of the aforesaid reference at their end, conducted fresh vigilance inquiry ^{by} ~~to~~ ^{the} ~~of~~ their then Dy Suptd. Police, after registering P.E.4/83 at their end, in the Delhi branch of C.B.I. against the applicant. During the course of these inquiries the C.B.I. investigating officer had taken in possession from your end, a number of files and the details of the same are spelt out as under: -

- a) File No.24(401)/vig/81, pertaining to the vigilance inquiry conducted against the applicant which contained various notings and correspondence made by the senior officers of the applicant
- b) File No.5/38/74-H(P)/Estt.Vol-3 relating to the D.E. against the undersigned from page 1-9, containing various notings and correspondence.

6) Sir, I'm sure these files must have been returned to you after the conclusion of the Vigilance inquiry proceedings by the C.V.C. during the year 1989, exonerating the applicant of all the charges, earlier framed against the applicant by the aforementioned disciplinary authorities (Chief Secretary, Govt. of Delhi)
