O. 3610, dated the 12th November, 1957.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control, the Lieutenant-Governor of the Union territory of Himachal Pradesh shall, in relation to the said territory, exercise the powers of a State Government under section 126 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (5 of 1908).
