NOTIFICATION  
MEDICINAL AND TOILET PREPARATIONS

No. 15 In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the  
Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administra  
of the Union territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli shall, subject  
the control of the President and until further orders, exercise  
the powers of the collecting Government under clause (a) of  
section 2 (namely, to empower any person to exercise all or an  
of the powers of an excise officer), and under section 4  
(namely, to grant, in the circumstances stated therein, rebate  
of duty), of the Medicinal and Toilet Preparations (Excise Dut  
Act, 1955 (16 of 1955), within that Union territory.
