

ADMINISTRATORS OF UNION TERRITORIES TO EXERCISE THE POWERS AND DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTIONS 6(1) AND 12(c) OF THE COTTON GINNING AND PRESSING FACTORIES ACT, 1925.

O. 45, dated the 23rd December, 1957.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in partial modification of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Industry and Supply, No. S. R. O. 460, dated the 24th August, 1950, and the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs, No. S. R. O. 2536, dated the 1st November, 1956, the President hereby directs that the Administrators of all the Union territories shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 6 and clause (c) of section 12 of the Cotton Ginning and Pressing Factories Act, 1925 (12 of 1925), in the Union territories under their respective administration.
