

NOTIFICATION

S.O. 670(E) In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 70 of the Delhi Police Act, 1978 (34 of 1978), and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. 423 (E) dated 1st July, 1978, the Central Government hereby empowers every Additional Commissioner of Police, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police, ^{and} Assistant Commissioner of Police to exercise and perform in relation to all areas in the Union territory of Delhi the powers and duties of an Executive Magistrate under sections 107, 111, 113, 115, 116, 117, 118 and 121, Sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 122 and section 124 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974).
