

ADMINISTRATORS OF UNION TERRITORIES OTHER THAN DELHI TO DISCHARGE
THE FUNCTIONS OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT UNDER ORDER XXVII
OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE TO THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE, 1908.

S. R. O. 282, dated the 21st January, 1958.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Law, No. S. R. O. 699, dated the 8th April, 1953, the President hereby directs that the functions assigned to the Central Government by Order XXVII of the First Schedule to the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (5 of 1908) shall be discharged, in relation to a Union territory other than Delhi, by the administrator of that Union territory, by whatever designation he may be appointed.
