LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF HIMACHAL PRADESH AND CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF DELHI, MANIPUR, TRIPURA AND THE ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS TO EXERCISE THE POWERS AND DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF A STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTIONS 56, 57(1), 58(3), AND 71(1) AND (2) OF THE INDIAN PARTNERSHIP ACT, 1932.



S. O. 134, dated the 18th February, 1958.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of all previous notifications on the subject, in so far as they relate to the Act mentioned below, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant-Governor of Himachal Pradesh and the Chief Commissioners of Delhi, Manipur, Tripura and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall, subject to control of the President, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of a State Government under section 56, subsection (1) of section 57, sub-section (3) of section 58 and sub-sections

(1) and (2) of section 71 of the Indian Partnership Act, 1932 (9 of 1932).
