

LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF HIMACHAL PRADESH AND CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF DELHI TO EXERCISE POWERS UNDER PARAGRAPH 2(f)(iv) OF THE EMPLOYEES' PROVIDENT FUNDS SCHEME, 1952.

S. O. 422, dated the 25th March, 1958.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the powers exercisable by appropriate Government under the *Explanation* to sub-clause (iv) of clause (f) of paragraph 2 of the Employees' Provident Funds Scheme, 1952 to specify the authority to declare a person as an apprentice shall, subject to the control of the President, also be exercisable by the Chief Commissioner of the Union territory of Delhi and the Lieutenant-Governor of the Union territory of Himachal Pradesh, within their respective territories.
