G.S.R. 349.- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), the Central Government hereby directs that the powers exercisable by it under section 15(1) of the said Act shall be exercisable also by the Administrator of a Union Territory, subject to the condition that no rules made by the Administrator in exercise of the aforesaid powers shall have effect in so far as they are repugnant to any rules made under the said section by the Central Government.
