S.O. 652. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Irrigation and Power, No. EL-III-52 (17), dated the 16<sup>th</sup> November, 1953 and in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. 10/53/61-A.N., dated the 19<sup>th</sup> December, 1953, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant Governor of Himachal Pradesh and the Chief Commissioners of Manipur, Tripura and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall discharge, within their respective Union territories, all the functions of the State Government under the Indian Electricity Act, 1910 (19 of 1910) and the Rules made thereunder, except under the following provisions, namely:-

Sections 13, 18, 314, 316 and 55 of the said Act. Clause VIII of the Schedule to the said Act; and Rules 6, 123 and 134 of the said Rules.

S.O. 1014. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. 2/26/49 (II) Public dated the 12<sup>th</sup> January, 1950 and also in partial supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the late Ministry of State No. 104-7 dated the 24<sup>th</sup> August, 1950 in so far as it relates to the Census Act, 1948 (37 of 1948), the President hereby directs that the powers and functions of the State Government under the Census Act, 1948 (37 of 1948) shall respectively be exercised and discharged by the Administrators of Union territories within their respective jurisdictions.

S.O. 1167. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant Governor of Himachal Pradesh and the Chief Commissioners of Delhi, Manipur and Tripura shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers of the State Government under sub-section (2) of section 7 of the Colonial Laws Amendment Act, 1952 (46 of 1952) within their respective jurisdictions.
