S.O. 652. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Irrigation and Power No. EL-II-12(17), dated the 16th November, 1953 and in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. 10/53/61-A.H., dated the 19th December, 1953, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant Governor of Himachal Pradesh and the Chief Commissioners of Manipur, Tripura and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall discharge, within their respective Union territories, all the functions of the State Government under the Indian Electricity Act, 1910 (99/1910) and the Rules made thereunder, except under the following provisions, namely: -
