S.O. 1961 - In exercise of the power conferred by article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the power of the Central Government to grant advances under rule 10 of the A.C. India Service (Provident Fund) Rules, 1955 to members of All India Service serving in the Union territories shall, subject to the conditions prescribed in the said rule, be exercised by the Administrators of the Union territories within their respective jurisdictions.

S.O. 2291 - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrators of the Union territories of Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur and Tripura shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the appropriate Government under the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1957 (319/1957), within their respective jurisdictions, in relation to any such establishment as is referred to in sub-clause (2) of clause (a) of section 2 of that Act.

S.O. 81 - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in pursuance of the Notification of the Government of India -

- (i) in the late Department of Commerce No. 183-Ind. 3(a)/42 dated 26th September, 1952 (in so far as it relates to the Chief Commissioner of Delhi);
- (ii) in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. 26/1/49-A.N. dated 21st February, 1950, and
- (iii) in the late Ministry of States No. 104-J dated 24th August, 1950 (in so far as it relates to the Chief Commissioner of Himachal Pradesh, Tripura and Manipur).

The President hereby directs that the Lieutenant Governor or the Chief Commissioner, as the case may be, of the Union territories of Himachal Pradesh, Delhi, Manipur, Tripura and Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the ~~Delhi~~ Collection Statistics Act, 1953 (32 of 1953), within their respective Union territories.

S.O. 82 - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrators of the Union territories of Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and the Dadar, Diu and Daman Islands shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under section 17 of the Cinematograph Act, 1952 (37 of 1952), within their respective jurisdictions.
