S.O. 1961. - In exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the powers of the Central Government to sanction advances under rule 10 of the All-India Services (Provident Fund) Rules, 1955, to members of the India Service serving in the Union Territories shall subject to the conditions prescribed in the said Rule, be exercised by the Administrators of the Union Territories within their respective jurisdictions.

S.O. 2291. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrators of the Union Territories of Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the appropriate Government under the Employment Exchange (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959 (31 of 1959), within their respective jurisdictions, in relation to any new establishment as is referred to in sub-clause (2) of clause (a) of section 2 of that Act.

S.O. 81. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in pursuance of the Notification of the Governor of Andhra -

(i) in the late Department of Commerce No. 183-Ind. 3/2/42 dated 26th September, 1942 (in so far as it relates to the Chief Commissioner of Delhi);

(ii) in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. 26/1/49-A.N. dated 21st February, 1950; and

(iii) in the late Ministry of States No. 104-T dated 24th August, 1950 (in so far as it relates to the Chief Commissioners of Financial Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir),

The President hereby directs that the Lieutenant Governor or the Chief Commissioner, as the case may be, of the Union Territories of Haryana, Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir and the State of Bihar shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Data Collection Statistics Act, 1953 (32 of 1953), within their respective Union Territories.
