II (S.O. 83) dated the 9<sup>th</sup> January, 1961, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant Governor of Himachal Pradesh and the Chief Commissioners of Tripura shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Indian Christian Marriage Act, 1872 (15 of 1872), within their respective territories.
