G. S. R. 522. — In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant Governor of ~~Goa, Daman and Diu~~ shall, in relation to that Union territory, discharge the functions of the Central Government (i) under section 5 of the Indian Passport Act, 1920 (34 of 1920); (ii) under rules 2 and 4 of the Indian Passport Rules, 1950; (iii) under rule 3 of the Indian Registration of Foreigners Rules, 1939; (iv) in making orders of the nature specified in clauses (c), (cc), (d), (f) and (g) of sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 (31 of 1946); and (v) under the Foreigners Order, 1948, subject to following conditions, namely:—

- (a) that in exercise of such functions, the said Lieutenant Governor shall comply with such general or special directions as the Central Government may from time to time issue; and
- (b) that notwithstanding this entrustment, the Central Government may itself exercise any of the said functions should it deem fit to do so in any case.

G. S. R. 523. — In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control and until further orders, the Lieutenant Governor of ~~Goa, Daman and Diu~~ shall, in relation to that Union territory, discharge the functions of the Central Government (i) for obtaining an indemnity bond in respect of a foreigner entering India; (ii) for taking any action in respect of the terms and conditions of the bond; and (iii) for incurring any expenditure on the foreigner and his family during their residence in India and on their repatriation out of India.

S.O. 1220. — In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrator of ~~Goa, Daman and Diu~~ shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the Indian Trade Unions Act, 1926 (16 of 1926) as extended to ~~Goa, Daman and Diu~~ (Laws) Regulation, 1962, within the Union territory of ~~Goa, Daman and Diu~~.

S.O. 2208. — In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrator (who for known as the Chief Commissioner, the Lieutenant Governor or the Administrator) of the Union territories of Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir and Jizabur Island and Lakshadweep, Maniyar and Andaman Islands shall, with subject to his control and within their respective frontier territories, exercise the powers and discharge the functions appropriate government under sub-section (1) of section 13 of the Employees' Provident Funds Act, 1952 (19 of 1952).
