S.O. 2739. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrator of Pondicherry shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers, and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the Indian Trade Unions Act, 1926 (16 of 1926), as extended to Pondicherry under the Pondicherry (Laws) Regulation, 1963 (7 of 1963) within the territory of Pondicherry.

S.O. 3165. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that, subject to <sup>his</sup> control of and until further orders, the Administrator of the Union Territory of Pondicherry shall exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under -

- (i) the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (1 of 1894) except those under the provisos to sub-section (1) of section 55; and
- (ii) the Land Acquisition (Companies) Rules, 1963
