

LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR OF HIMACHAL PRADESH AND CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF DELHI, MANIPUR, TRIPURA AND THE ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE DRUGS AND MAGIC REMEDIES (OBJECTIONABLE ADVERTISEMENTS) ACT, 1954.

S. R. O. 3350, dated the 12th October, 1957.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Government of India, Ministry of Health, Notification No. F. 8-10/55-D, dated the 16th April, 1955 and in partial modification of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs, No. S.R.O. 2536, dated the 1st November, 1956, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant-Governor of Himachal Pradesh and the Chief Commissioners of the Union territories of Delhi, Manipur, Tripura and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisements) Act, 1954 (21 of 1954), within their respective Union territories.
