

(120) G.S.R. 44. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrator for the time being of a Union territory (who then called a Lieutenant Governor or a Chief Commissioner or an Administrator) shall, in relation to the Union territory concerned, discharge the functions of the Central Government under clause (2) of sub-section (2) of section 3, and sub-sections (1) and (4) of section 4, of the Foreigners Act, 1946 (31 of 1946), subject to the following conditions, namely:-

- (a) that the functions so entrusted shall be exercised in respect of persons to whom Chapter II of the Foreigners (Internment) Order, 1962, applies;
- (b) that in the exercise of such functions the said Administrator shall comply with the such general or special directions as the Central Government may from time to time issue; and
- (c) that, notwithstanding this entrustment, the Central Government may itself exercise any of the said functions should it deem fit to do so in any case.
