S.O. 206. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrator of the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under section 7 of the Dadra and Nagar Haveli (Civil Courts and Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulation, 1963 (8 of 1963).

G.O.R. 962. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrator of the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli shall, in relation to that Union Territory, discharge the functions of the Central Government (i) under section 1 of the Indian Passport Act, 1920 (34 of 1920); (ii) under rules 2 and 4 of the Indian Passport Rules, 1950; (iii) under rule 3 of the Registration of Foreigners Rules, 1939; (iv) in making orders of the nature specified in clauses (a), (b), (c), (cc), (d), (e), (f) and (g) of sub-section (2) of section 3 and sub-sections (1) and (4) of section 4 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 (31 of 1946); and (v) under the Foreigners Order, 1948, subject to the following conditions, namely:-

- (a) that in the exercise of such functions the said Administrator shall comply with such general or special directions that as the Central Government may from time to time issue;
- (b) that the functions entrusted under clause (g) of sub-section (2) of section 3 and sub-sections (1) and (4) of section 4 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 (31 of 1946) shall be exercised in respect of persons to whom Chapter II of the Foreigners (Entrance) Order, 1962, applies; and
- (c) that notwithstanding this entrustment, the Central Government may itself exercise any of the said functions should it deem fit to do so in any case.
