S.O. 263. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control, the Administrator of the Union territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli shall, in relation to that Union territory, discharge the functions of the Central Government (i) for obtaining an indemnity bond in respect of foreigners entering India; (ii) for taking any action under the terms and conditions of the bond; and (iii) for incurring any expenditure on the foreigner and his family during their residence in India and on their repatriation out of India.

S.O. 2079. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to direct that subject to his control and until further orders, the Administrators (whether known as Lieutenant Governor, Chief Commissioner, or Administrator) of the Union territories of Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Pondicherry and Jammu and Kashmir, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Goa, Daman and Diu and Pondicherry, shall, within their respective territories, discharge the functions of the Central Government under sub-sections (2) and (7) of section 2 of the Personal Injuries (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1962 (59 of 1962).

S.O. 2402. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administrators (whether known as Lieutenant Governor, Chief Commissioner or Administrator) of the Union territories of Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Pondicherry and Jammu and Kashmir, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Goa, Daman and Diu and Pondicherry shall, until further orders, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Personal Injuries (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1962 (59 of 1962) within their respective territories.

S.O. 2506. - In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Notification of the Government of India in the late Home Department No. F.176/37-Sub. dated 18<sup>th</sup> April, 1957 in so far as it relates to discharge of functions under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) by the Chief Commissioner of Delhi and also in partial modification of the Notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs S.R.O. No. 2536 dated 1<sup>st</sup> November, 1964, the President hereby directs that, subject to his control and until further orders, the Chief Commissioner of the Union territory of Delhi shall exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), within his territorial jurisdiction.
