[ART. 239] Rules and Orders under the Constitution

Administrators of Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Laccadive, Minicov and Amindivi Islands to discharge the functions of the Central Government under certain rules of the Explosives Rules, 1940.

S. R. O. 3363, dated the 14th October, 1957.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of all previous notifications on the subject, the President hereby directs that the Administrators of Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and the Laccadive, Minicoy and Amindivi Islands, shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, discharge the functions of the Central Government under the proviso to rule 82 of the Explosives Rules, 1940, under the proviso to rule 83 of the said Rules and under rule 93 of the said Rules in their respective administrations.
