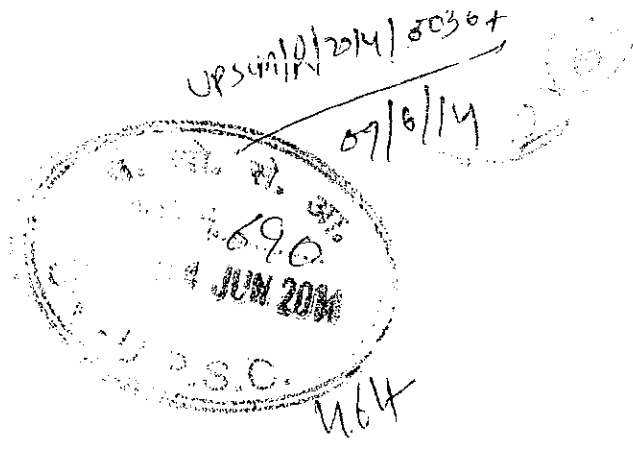

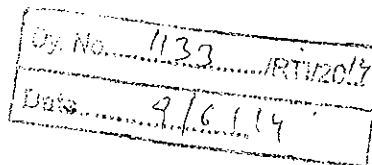

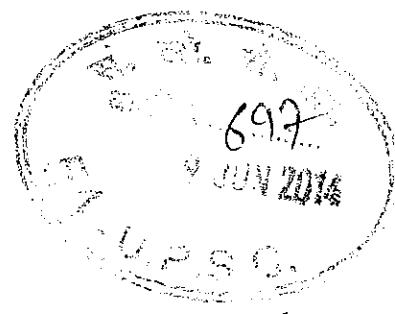

## INITIAL POLICE FORCES (ASSISTANT COMMANDANTS) EXAMINATION, 2005

**IMPORTANT**

### 1. APPLICATION FORM :

Candidates must apply in the Common Application Form devised by the Commission for its examinations, which can be purchased from the designated Head Post Offices/Post Offices (specified in the Appendix III of the Notice) throughout the country against cash payment of Rs.20/- (Rupees twenty only). Each such Form can be used only once and only for one examination.

In case of any difficulty in obtaining Application Forms from the designated HPOs/POs, the candidates should immediately contact the concerned Post Master or UPSC's "FORMS SUPPLY MONITORING CELL" over Telephone No.011-23309366/Fax No.011-23367310.

### 2. LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS :

All applications must reach the "Secretary, Union Public Service Commission, Dholpur House, Sháhjahan Road, New Delhi - 110 069" either by hand or by Post/Speed Post or by Courier, on or before the 6th June, 2005.

However, in respect of candidates residing abroad or in certain remote localities specified in the Notice the last date for receipt of applications by Post Speed Post only (not by Hand or by Courier) is 13th June, 2005.

### 3. FACILITATION COUNTER AND WEBSITE FOR GUIDANCE OF CANDIDATES :

In case of any guidance/information/clarification regarding their applications, candidature etc. candidates can contact UPSC's Facilitation Counter near Gate 'C' of its campus in person or over Telephone No.011-23385271/011-23381125/011-233098543 on working days between 10.00 hrs. and 17.00 hrs.

The Commission also has Website at address : <http://www.upsc.gov.in> over which the candidates can obtain details of the examination as well as information about registration of their applications, venue of the examination and results etc.

### 4. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS :

Candidates are advised to read carefully the Instructions/Guidelines for Filling up the Application Form (Appendix II), "Special Instructions To the Candidates for Objective Type Tests" (Appendix IV) and "Special Instructions To the Candidates for Conventional Type Tests" (Appendix V).

### 5. MOBILE PHONES NOT ALLOWED :

(a) Mobiles Phones, Pagers or any other communication devices are not allowed inside the premises where the examination is being conducted. Any infringement of these instructions shall entail disciplinary action including ban from future examinations.

(b) Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items including Mobile Phones/Pagers to the venue of the examination, as arrangements for safekeeping cannot be assured.

Citizen of India shall, except with the consent of the Central Government, be employed under these Rules.

Provided that nothing contained in these Rules shall debar the appointment, enrolment or employment of a subject of India or Bhutan under these Rules.

(ii) Sex: Both Male and Female candidates are eligible for appointment to the post of Assistant Commandants in CRPF. However, for appointment to the post of Assistant Commandants in BSF, ITBP and CISB, only Male candidates are eligible.

(iii) Age Limits :

(A) A candidate must have attained the age of 20 years and must not have attained the age of 25 years on the 1st day of the

(b) The upper age limit prescribed above will be relaxable

(i) upto a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe.

(ii) upto a maximum of three years in the case of candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes who are eligible to avail of reservation applicable to such candidates.

(iii) upto a maximum of five years for Central Government Servants in accordance with the existing instructions of the Central Government. Ex-Servicemen will also be eligible for this relaxation. However, the total relaxation claimed on account of Government Service will be limited to five years.

the period from 1st January, 1980 to the 31st day of December, 1987.

Note I : Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes who are also covered under any other clause of Para 3(iii)(b) above viz those coming under the category of Central Government Servants/Ex-servicemen or persons domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir, will be eligible for grant of cumulative age-relaxation under both the categories.

Note II : The term ex-servicemen will apply to the persons who are defined as ex-servicemen in the Ex-servicemen (CR) employment in Civil Services and Posts Rules, 1979, as amended from time to time.

Note III : The term Central Government Servants in Para 3(iii)(b) above will apply to persons who are defined as Government Servants in the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1955 as amended from time to time.

SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED.

The date of birth accepted by the Commission is that entered in the Matriculation or Secondary School Leaving Certificate or in a certificate recognised by an Indian University as equivalent to Matriculation or an extract from a Register of Matriculates maintained by a University, which extract must be certified by the proper authority of the University or in the higher Secondary or an equivalent examination certificate.

No other document relating to age like the Census-cards, affidavits, birth extracts from Municipal Corporations, service records and the like will be accepted.

The Commission Matriculation/Secondary School Leaving Certificate or the part of its certificate which includes the date of birth of candidates is as follows :

NOTE 1 : Candidate's Date of Birth (as per A Date of Birth has been entered by them and entered in the records of the Commission for the purpose of admission to an Examination, no change will be allowed subsequently for all other Examination of the Commission on any grounds whatsoever.

NOTE 2 : The candidates should exercise due care while entering their Date of Birth in Column 8 of the Application Form for the Examination. If on verification at any subsequent stage, any variation is found in their Date of Birth from the one entered in their Matriculation or equivalent Examination Certificate, discrepancy will be raised by the Commission under the Rules.

iv. Minimum Educational Qualification : A candidate must hold a Bachelor's degree of a University incorporated by an Act of the Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or be regarded as deemed as a Lawfully and Section 13 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or possess an equivalent qualification.

NOTE 1 : Candidates who have a graduation





also the candidates who intend to appear in such a qualifying examination in the year 2005 will also be eligible for admission to the examination. Such candidates will be admitted to the examination if otherwise eligible but the admission would be deemed to be provisional and subject to cancellation if they do not produce proof of having passed the requisite examination along with the Detailed Application Form which will be required to be submitted to the Commission by the candidates who after qualifying on the result of the written part of the examination are also declared qualified in the Physical Standards/ Physical Efficiency Tests and Medical Standard Tests.

**NOTE II :** In exceptional cases the Union Public Service Commission may treat a candidate who has not any of the foregoing qualifications as a qualified candidate, provided that he/she has passed an examination conducted by the other institutions, the standard of which in the opinion of the Commission justifies his/her admission to the examination.

**NOTE III :** Candidates possessing professional and technical qualifications which are recognised by Government as equivalent to professional and technical degree would also be eligible for admission to the examination.

**NOTE IV :** Restriction on re-appearances of candidates is finally notified/ recommended earlier.

A candidate who has been finally selected on the basis of an earlier examination to the post of Assistant Commandants in any of the forces participating in the Central Police Forces Examination will not be eligible to appear at a subsequent examination for recruitment of Assistant Commandants in the participating CPFs.

**VI. Physical Standards :**  
Candidates must meet the prescribed Physical and Medical Standards for a position of Central Police Forces Examination, 2005 specified in Appendix III to be Non-A.

**VII. Possession of NCC 'B' or 'C' Certificates :**

Possession of NCC 'B' or 'C' Certificate will be a desirable qualification. These candidates will be given consideration at the time of Interview/ Personality Test only.

**Fee :**  
Candidates residing in India seeking admission to examination must pay to the Commission a fee of Rs 100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) through a single Central Recruitment Fee Stamp. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes are not required to pay any fee. No fee exemption is, however, available to OBC Candidates and if they are required to pay the prescribed fee in full.

The Central Recruitment Fee Stamp of requisite denomination (NOT postage stamps) may be obtained from the post office as specified in the application form and the specimen thereof. This stamp must be placed on the application form in such a manner that the impression of the cancellation mark partially overflows on the application form and the balance part of the stamp is on the application form. The balance part of the cancellation mark should be clear and distinct to facilitate the identification of the Post Office of issue. Candidates residing abroad will have to pay the prescribed fee in the form of India's Foreign Currency Convertible Bond (FCCB) which should be obtained as per the instructions of the Ministry of Finance, Government of India.

Candidates should note that in case a communication is received from their employer by the Commission withholding permission to the candidates applying for appearing at the examination, their application will be liable to be rejected; candidature will be liable to be cancelled.

**NOTE I :** While filling in the Application Form, the candidate should carefully indicate his/her choice for the Centre for the Examination. More than one application from a candidate giving different centres will not be accepted in any case. Even if a candidate sends more than one completed application the Commission will consider only the first one.

**NOTE I :** APPLICATIONS NOT ACCOMPANIED BY THE PRESCRIBED FEE (UNLESS REMISSION OF FEE IS CLAIMED) SHALL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED.

**NOTE II :** FEE ONCE PAID SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES NOR CAN THE FEE BE HELD IN RESERVE FOR ANY OTHER EXAMINATION OR SELECTION.

**5. HOW TO APPLY :**

(a) The UPSC have developed an application form common for all their examinations, which will be processed on computerised machines. This application form along with an Information Brochure containing general instructions for filling up the form, an acknowledgement card and an envelope for sending the application is obtainable from the designated Head Post Offices/Post Offices throughout the country as listed in Appendix-III of Notice against cash payment of Rs.20/- (Rupees Twenty only). Form should be purchased from the designated Post Offices only, and not from any other agency. This form can be used only once and for only one examination. Candidates must use the form supplied with the Information Brochure only and they should in no case use photocopy/ reproducible/ unauthorised printed copy of the form. The candidates should fill up in the relevant places of the Acknowledgement Card, their Application Form Number (8-digit) and the name of the examination. The applicants are required to affix the postage stamp of Rs. 6/- on the Acknowledgement Cards and send the same along with application form to UPSC. If an applicant fails to affix the postage stamp of requisite amount, his/her acknowledgement card will not be despatched and Commission will not be responsible for non receipt of acknowledgement card by the applicant. The duly filled in application form and the acknowledgement card should then be mailed in the special envelope supplied with the information brochure. Candidates should also write the name of the examination viz. "Central Police Forces (Assistant Commandants) Examination, 2005" on the envelope before despatching it to "Secretary, Union Public Service Commission, Dholpur House, Shahjahan Road, New Delhi -110069".

(b) All candidates, whether already in Government Service, Government owned industrial undertakings or other similar organisations or in private employment, should submit their applications direct to the Commission. If any candidate forwards his/her application through his/her employer and it reaches the Union Public Service Commission late, the application, even if submitted to the employer before the closing date, will not be considered.

Persons already in Government service, whether in permanent or temporary capacity or as work-charged employees or those casual or daily rated employees or those serving under the Public Enterprises are however, required to submit an undertaking that they have informed in writing their Head of Officer/Department that they have applied for the Examination.

Candidates should note that in case a communication is received from their employer by the Commission withholding permission to the candidates applying for appearing at the examination, their application will be liable to be rejected; candidature will be liable to be cancelled.

**NOTE I :** While filling in the Application Form, the candidate should carefully indicate his/her choice for the Centre for the Examination. More than one application from a candidate giving different centres will not be accepted in any case. Even if a candidate sends more than one completed application the Commission will consider only the first one.

If any candidate appears at a centre other than the one indicated by the Commission in his/her Admission Certificate, the papers of such a candidate will not be evaluated and his/her candidature will be liable to cancellation.

**NOTE 2 :** Since these Application Forms are to be processed in a Computerised System, due care should be taken by the candidates to fill up their Application Form correctly. Necessary instructions for filling up the form may be seen at Appendix-II. Incomplete or defective applications shall be summarily rejected. No representation or correspondence regarding such rejection shall be entertained under any circumstances.

**NOTE 3 :** Candidates are not required to submit along with their applications any certificate in support of their claims regarding age, educational qualifications, Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes etc. which will be verified by the Commission at the time of Personality Test/Interview.

The candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility conditions for admission to the examination. Their admission at all the stages of examination for which they are admitted by the Commission viz. Written Examination, Physical and Medical Standards Tests and Interview/ Personality Test will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If on verification at any time before or after the Written Examination, Physical and Medical Standards Tests, Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and Interview/Personality Test, it is found that they do not fulfil any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the Commission.

If any of their claims is found to be incorrect, they will render themselves liable to disciplinary action by the Commission in terms of Rule 14 of the Rules for the Central Police Forces (Assistant Commandants) Examination, 2005 reproduced below.

A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission to be guilty of:

- (i) Obtaining support for his candidature by the following means, namely :
  - (a) offering illegal gratification to, or
  - (b) applying pressure on, or
  - (c) blackmailing or threatening to blackmail any person connected with the conduct of the examination, or
  - (ii) impersonating or
  - (iii) procuring impersonation by any person, or
  - (iv) submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with, or
  - (v) making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information, or
  - (vi) resorting to the following means in connection with his/her candidature for the examination, namely:
    - (a) obtaining copy of question paper through improper means,
    - (b) finding out the particulars of the persons connected with secret work relating to the examination,
    - (c) influencing the examiners, or
    - (vii) using unfair means during the examination, or
    - (viii) writing obscene matter or drawing obscene sketches in the scripts, or
    - (ix) misbehaving in the examination hall including tearing of the scripts provoking fellow examinees to boycott examination, creating disorderly scene and the like, or
    - (x) harassing or doing bodily harm to the staff employed by the Commission for the conduct of their examinations, or
    - (xi) being in possession of or using any cellular/mobile phone pager or any other electronic communication device during the examination.

(xii) violating any rule issued by the Commission for the conduct of the examination, or

(a) to be disqualified from the examination if he is a candidate of the examination, or  
 (b) to be detained for a specified period by the Commission, or  
 (c) to be removed from the employment of the Government, or  
 (d) if he is an employee of the Government, to be removed from the service of the Government, or  
 (e) if he is an employee of a public body, to be removed from the service of that body, or  
 (f) if he is an employee of a private body, to be removed from the service of that body.

**6. LAST DATE FOR RECEIVING APPLICATIONS :**

(a) The Commission will receive the applications at the Secretary, Union Public Service Commission, Dholpur House, Shahjahan Road, New Delhi-110069, upto the last date specified in the advertisement for the examination, and the applications received after that date will be considered only if they are received by Post/Speed Post or Registered Post before 15.00 hours on the last date specified in the advertisement for the examination. The Commission will not be responsible for the delay in receipt of applications after the last date specified in the advertisement for the examination, if the delay is caused by the delay in transmission of the applications through the post.

Candidates who are unable to extend their time to the last date specified in the advertisement for the examination, or those who are unable to do so, should apply to the Commission for an extension of time to do so. The benefit of such an extension will be at the discretion of the Commission.

**NOTE (I) :** Candidates should note that the Commission will not be responsible for any delay in the receipt of applications after the last date specified in the advertisement for the examination, if the delay is caused by the delay in transmission of the applications through the post.
