be loaded with the maximum rates of duties and taxes for the purpose of comparison prices. If reimbursement of custom duty/excise duty/ GST is intended as extra over the quoted prices, the bidder must specifically say so. In the absence of any such stipulation it will presumed that the prices quoted are firm and final and no claim on account of such duties will be entertained after the opening of tenders. If a bidder chooses to quote a price inclusive of any duty and does not confirm inclusive of such duty so included is firm and final, he should clearly indicate the rate of such duty and quantum of excise duty included in the price. Failure to do so may result in ignoring of such offers summarily. If a bidder is exempted from payment of custom duty/excise duty/GST up to any value of supplies from them, they should clearly state that no duty will be charged by to the limit them up which they may exemption If any concession is have. available in regard rate/quantum of custom duty/excise duty/vat it should be brought out clearly. Stipulations like excise duty/customs duty and GST was presently not applicable but the same will be charged if it becomes leviable later on, will not be accepted. Additional Commercial Points Clarified during Meeting and will form a part of the current tender.

- i. In case offers are received both from manufacturers as well as from their authorised representative, offers from manufacturers only shall be considered and offers from their representatives shall be summarily rejected.
 - ii. One cannot represent two different OEMs or quote on their behalf for the same item in one tender.
 - iii. The Indian bidder/ authorised dealer/distributor should be a corporate in India registered under the Company Act, 1956 or a company statutory body own by Central / State Government.
 - 2. All other terms and conditions will remain unchanged. The Bidders may submit their bid accordingly.
