D/21013/3275/13.09.2018/P-1 DATED 30.11.2018 FLOATED ON CPP PORTAL AND SCHEDULE TO BE OPENED ON 17.01.2019 (TECH BID) FOR SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF GENETIC ANALYZER QTY. 09 UNITS FOR ONE UNIT EACH AT (i) BHOPAL (ii) GUWAHATI (iii) HYDERABAD (iv) KOLKATA (v) PUNE AND (v) 04 UNITS-AT CHANDIGARH UNDER DFSS.

A pre-bid meeting under the Chairmanship of Director of Women Safety, New Delhi was held on 11.12.2018 at 1100 AM to address the points raised by prospective bidders in connection with Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) issued by MHA on 30.11.2018 floated on CPP portal for procurement of Genetic Analyzer - Qty. 09 Nos. for CFSLs, of DFSS. After discussion in the pre-bid meeting, after approval of competent authority, following amendments are hereby issued against the subject GTE. 


