**Subject:- United Nations Selection Assistance and Assessment Team 2020-2022(renamed 2022-2024): Revised list for Assessment regarding**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 18.01.2022.on the above mentioned subject and to say that United Nations has decided to reduce the maximum number of candidates to 150, including at least 25% women for the Assessment of Mission(AMS) SOP after monitoring the situation with COVID-19 and its potential impact on upcoming SAAT visit. The decision also serves deploying fewer instructors due to CoVID 19 with the ultimate goal of running the AMS while keeping in mind the wellbeing, safety and best favorable conditions for all concerned parties.

2. Under the above decision of maximum number of candidates to be 150, the nominations of 264 have been segregated **at appendix-A** and now the AMS is going to be conducted from 31.01.2022 to 07<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 for only 150 candidates(list at appendix -B). The assessment of remaining candidates may be conducted in due course of time. The ibid letter dtd 18.01.2022 is superseded by this communication.

3. Therefore, all concerned are requested to relieve only listed officers as per enclosed appendix to report to the Commandant, 22<sup>nd</sup> ITBP Bn, National UN CIVPOL Centre, Tigri Camp, New Delhi by **29<sup>th</sup> January, 2022** with the direction to come along with the followings:-

- g) Two sets of Uniforms
- h) Individual PPE Kits
- i) a negative RTPCR test report done 72hrs prior
- j) Valid driving license
- k) Identity Card and passport photographs
- l) 9mm pistol with 25 rounds



4. All the above requirements/documents are mandatory and any candidate who fails to bring any of the above requirements/docs will not be allowed to participate in the UNSAAT. UNCIVPOL may provide the accommodation facilities for the candidates at a nearby location to the UNPOL Centre so as to minimize the risk of exposure to the CoVID. If not provided by UNCIVPOL Centre, then officers are to make their own arrangements for stay and transportation in Delhi.

5. The guidelines issued by the Central Govt. to mitigate COVID-19 have to be strictly adhered to during the assessment and it is the responsibility of individual officer/participant to follow all the CoVID protocols i.e :-

- i. Masks to be mandatory for every participant.
- ii. Hand Sanitizers mandatory to be used by everyone.
- iii. Social distancing while conducting AMS.

6. All officers may be directed to fill-up their EASP form containing latest information/details and submit the same in soft and hard copy to the Commandant, National UN CIVPOL Centre upon their arrival along with photographs. The format of EASP circulated is already available on MHA website. No hand written/unsigned EASP will be entertained.

7. It is the responsibility of the sponsoring State/Organizations/Departments to ensure that the nominated officers fulfill all the eligibility conditions circulated by this Ministry's communication dated 15.07.2020 and should be clear from disciplinary/vigilance angle. Failure to meet the guidelines may result in cancellation of the candidature.

1. The Police Division presents its compliments to the Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations and refers to our PolDiv/1565/21 of 31 December 2021 on the above.

2. In preparation for the upcoming SAAT visit, we have been closely monitoring the situation with COVID-19 and its potential impact on this important exercise. While we appreciate the support rendered and mitigation measures put in place so far, it has been decided to reduce the maximum number of candidates to 150, including at least 25% women (paragraph 13 of the AMS SOP refers). This decision falls under the provision of paragraph 10 of the Temporary Arrangements for the Assessment of Individual Police Officers (IPOs) and Formed Police Units (FPUs) for Deployment to Peacekeeping Operations and Special Political Missions which states "*PCCs are kindly requested to limit the number of nominees for the AMS/AOC to the minimum number of IPO/FPU personnel required for replacement or rotation in field missions, while retaining the percentage of women candidates as per applicable SOP*". The decision also serves deploying less AMS Instructors due to COVID-19 with the ultimate goal of running the AMS while keeping in mind the wellbeing, safety and best favourable conditions for all concerned parties.

3. The Police Division will provide you and the SAAT with the final list of candidates and remains available to run future SAAT visits, conditions permitting, to satisfy operational needs and your rotation plans.

4. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter as we look forward to jointly running a successful SAAT visit.
