NOTIFICATION

S.O. 2490.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 4 of the Departmental Inquiries (Enforcement of Attendance of Witnesses and Production of Documents) Act, 1972 (18 of 1972), the Central Government hereby specifies the Administrator (whether known as Lieutenant Governor, Chief Commissioner or Administrator) of every Union territory as an authority to exercise the power conferred on the Central Government by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the said Act in cases where the said Administrator or any officer subordinate to the said Administrator is the appointing authority in relation to persons against whom a departmental inquiry is being held.
